A84 Cambusmore – works to begin 11th October

Users of the A84 trunk road at Cambusmore, on the Stirling to Lochearnhead road, are set to benefit from a Transport Scotland investment of £160,000, in an essential road maintenance improvement scheme.

The work, which involves the complete resurfacing and lining of the road for a distance of 1328 metres (0.8 of a mile), will be supervised by Scotland Transerv, on behalf of Transport Scotland.

It is programmed to start on the 11th October, 2010, and will last for two weeks, Monday to Friday only, 7am to 7pm. For the safety of the public and workers alike a single lane closure will be in place. The traffic signals will be removed outwith the closure hours.

Emergency services will have unrestricted access at all times. Disruption to traffic flows will be kept to the absolute minimum.

A spokesman for Scotland Transerv said:

“This essential maintenance work will improve the safety of the road and significantly enhance the ride quality.”
