

## **Press Release – 5t Dec 2011 -1600 Update Landslip A83 – 0.5 miles east of RABT**

The safety of the public and our workforce is absolutely paramount and the monitoring of the area of the most recent landslip on the A83 continues. We are grateful to the public for their continuing support and patience.

The arrangements put in place on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> December (road open daily 0830 to 1600) will continue until the current weather patterns change.

Outwith the opening times a diversion route is in place via A83 Dalmally- A85 Tyndrum-A82 Tarbet. This will add an extra 26 miles to the journey. Importantly access is still available to Arrochar and the A814 and also Cairndow and the A815.

Diversion for traffic in both directions will be via A83 Inveraray – A819 Dalmally – A85 Tyndrum – A82 Tarbet. This will add an extra 26 miles to the journey
