

A83 Rest & Be Thankful –

Press Release 1st Dec 2001 -16:00 Update

A Diversion route is in place via A83 Dalmally- A85 Tyndrum-A82 Tarbet. This will add an extra 26 miles to the journey. Importantly access is still available to Arrochar and the A814 and also Cairndow and the A815.

A single lane clearance is now in effect to allow access for all emergency services vehicles only. The access arrangements will continue overnight.

Due to the continuing concerns our engineers have regarding the slope stability the closure will continue overnight.

The situation will be reviewed – at first light to-morrow morning.
