Roadworks A9 Cuaich, near Dalwhinnie

Users of the A9 at Cuiach, Dalwhinnie, are set to benefit from a Transport Scotland investment of £155,000 in a road improvement scheme. The works are to be carried out by Scotland TranServ on behalf of Transport Scotland.

This scheme is part of Transport Scotland's commitment to maintain and improve Scotland's trunk road network. The works involves a 50mm inlay of the existing surface, including deep structural patching, along with associated road markings, benefitting motorist with a safer, smoother drive.

The works will start on Monday 22nd March 2010 for a period of approximately 2 weeks, utilising daytime Convoy Working using Temporary Traffic Signals with a 10mph speed restriction, between 0730 and 1800hrs.

The Scheme starts approximately 2.6 miles north of the A889 Dalwhinnie junction and extends approximately 0.7 miles to the north.

Motorists should allow extra time for their journeys and pay attention to location and timings of the works on the A9, paying attention to the signs which will be in place throughout the works. For real time journey planning information visit www.trafficscotland.org
