### **A85 Re-surfacing Scheme – Carse of Trowan (A85 between Comrie and Crieff)**

A £160,000 package of works is set to bring benefits to users of the A85 trunk road between Comrie and Crieff at the Carse of Trowan. Scotland TranServ, acting on behalf of Transport Scotland, will carry out this essential carriageway maintenance on this vital trunk road.

Construction of the scheme is currently programmed to commence on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August and last for approximately 2 weeks.

During construction the trunk road will be reduced to one lane under temporary traffic signal control, with 10mph convoy working in place. The work will be carried out Monday to Friday, from 07.00 to 18.00 hours.

Out with working hours and throughout the weekends it is envisaged that traffic management will be lifted to assist the easy flow of traffic.

Local access will be maintained as far as possible and emergency services will have unrestricted access at all times.
