A82 Crianlarich High Friction Surfacing Works and Overnight Closure

Users of the A82 Tyndrum to Crianlarich trunk road will benefit from a Transport Scotland road improvement scheme to enhance safety at double bend under the railway bridge in Crianlarich.

The works are to be carried out by Scotland TranServ on behalf of Transport Scotland. The works will start on Monday 22nd March 2010 for a period of approximately 2 nights, weather permitting, utilising overnight closure of the A82 between Crianlarich and Tyndrum.

These works, which include High Friction Surfacing to improve the skid resistance of the surfacing at this complex area, will be carried out overnight by a number of road squads between 2200hrs and 0600hrs. To facilitate these works it is necessary to close the A82 between the A82/A85 Junction at Crianlarich and the A82/85 Junction at Tyndrum.

Local access for residents (etc) will be maintained and a signed diversion route will be in place. Through traffic will not be permitted apart from the Emergency Services. Information Boards have been erected on all major connecting routes to warn of the closure.

Motorists should consult the [Traffic Scotland.org](http://Traffic.Scotland.org) website for up to date information and plan their journey to avoid the closures or allow extra time for their journeys. Motorists should also pay attention to the location and timings of the Closure of the A82 and A85 between Crianlarich and Tyndrum.
