A9 Clunie Bridge- Repairs to accident damaged parapet

Work to repair the accident damaged parapet on the A9 Clunie Bridge, over Loch Faskally, starts at 8am on Wednesday 17th March, 2010.

The full bridge parapet, on both east and west sides, will be replaced during these works. The work will be supervised by Scotland Transerv on behalf of Transport Scotland.

To ensure the safety of road users and workers alike the northbound lane will be closed to traffic from the start of the works until Thursday 1st April 2010. During that period traffic signals will be in operation to allow both north and southbound traffic to pass. A speed restriction of 30 mph will be in place.

The work will be suspended for the Easter weekend with no traffic management in operation.

In phase two of the works the northbound lane will remain open with the southbound lane now closed to all traffic from 8am on Tuesday 6th April 2010 until Friday the 16th April 2010. Again traffic signals will be in operation to allow both north and southbound traffic to pass, with a speed restriction of 30mph in place.

Motorists should allow extra time for their journeys and pay attention to any advisory signs which will be in place throughout the works. For real time journey planning information visit www.trafficscotland.org
