A85 Trunk Road - Essential Carriageway Patching Works

Users of the A85 trunk road, between St Fillans and Lochearnhead, are set to benefit from a Transport Scotland Investment of 15k, in essential carriageway patching works. The work includes the repair of the extensive potholing issues which have developed following very adverse winter conditions.

For the safety of the public and workers alike the works will be carried out under a night time closure and be carried out over two nights, the 24th and 25th February, 2011, between 10pm and 6am. Outwith working hours the traffic management will be removed. Emergency vehicles will have access at all times and local access will be permitted as safety allows

The work will be carried out by Scotland Transerv on behalf of Transport Scotland. Appropriate signed diversions will be in place. Every effort will be made to ensure that the minimum of disruption is caused to the travelling public.

A spokesman for Scotland Transerv commented;

‘It is essential that we carry out these works with the minimum of delay and we are grateful to the travelling public for their patience. The works will significantly improve the running surface of the road.’
