A84 Blair Drummond Safari Park to A873 Junction

The works will commence on 8th February 2010 for a period of approximately 3 weeks, utilising daytime Convoy Working using Temporary Traffic Lights with a 10mph speed restriction, between 0900 and 1600hrs. The B8075 and A873 junctions will be controlled by manually operated stop/go boards when required. The Convoy System will not be used during the morning and evening peak periods.

The Scheme starts approximately 300 metres east of the Safari Park junction and extends approximately 1.5Km to the west side of the A873 Junction.

This scheme is part of the commitment by Transport Scotland to maintain and improve the Trunk Road network. The works involves either a 50mm inlay or overlay of the existing surface, including deep structural patching, along with associated road markings

Motorists should allow extra time for their journeys and pay attention to location and timings of the works on the A84.

Value of the works is approximately £214,000.
