Roadworks on the A835 Contin

Users of the A835 trunk road through the village of Contin are set to benefit from a £214,000 road maintenance scheme.

The maintenance scheme is part of Transport Scotland's ongoing investment in the A835 and will see the resurfacing of a total of 0.8 miles of carriageway.

The scheme, which commences to the south of Contin and continues through the village, is due to start at 7.30 am on Tuesday 4th May 2010..

For the safety of the public and workers traffic management will be in place, in lengths of around 300m, with single lane closure only. The public can be assured that there will be unrestricted access to the Polling Station, within the Community Centre, on General Election day . Every effort will also be made to keep disruption to a minimum and to allow access to local services.

The works which will be supervised by Scotland Transerv on behalf of Transport Scotland start at 7.30 am on Tuesday 4th May 2010 and are planned to be complete by 6pm on Friday 14th May 2010. The work will take place from 7.30am to 6pm Monday to Friday. There will be no weekend working.
