A828 Connel Bridge– Essential Damage Repair Works
Bridge Closure between 10pm and 6am from Sunday 4th December 2011 to Friday 9th December 2011. Normal traffic flows between 6am and 10pm each day.

Following recent damage caused by an over-height vehicle, the A828 Connel Bridge will be closed overnight for five nights starting Sunday 4th December to allow repairs to be carried out.

Scotland TranServ, acting on behalf of Transport Scotland, will carry out the essential repair works, which will involve replacing a number of overhead cross beams and carrying out repairs to parts of the cross beams' supporting structure. .

The road will be closed to all traffic, both vehicular and pedestrian, between 22.00 and 06.00 hours to ensure the safety of the public and to allow the contractor unrestricted access to complete the works as quickly as possible.

Access for fire, police and ambulance vehicles on emergency duties will be provided at all times.
