### **A82 Tarbet to Crianlarich Trunk Road – Safety Improvement and Drainage works. Road Closure starts 10pm Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2011**

Users of the A82 trunk road between Tarbet and Crianlarich are set to benefit from a Transport Scotland investment of £20,000 in safety improvement and drainage works.

The works which are to be carried out by Scotland TranServ, on behalf of Transport Scotland, get underway on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2011 for a period of 10 nights, utilising night time road closures between the hours of 10pm and 6am Sunday night to Thursday night. For the safety of the public and the workforce a road closure is mandatory.

The road shall be closed between the A82/ A83 Junction Tarbet, and the A82/A85 junction Crianlarich. We will work hard to ensure that a minimum of disruption is caused to traffic during these improvement works. Every effort will be made to allow local access and although there may be some delay, every effort will also be made to minimise disruption to local residents travelling to and from their properties. Emergency services will have access at all times.

This scheme is part of the commitment by Transport Scotland to maintain and improve the Trunk Road network. The works involve significant drainage improvements and the application of High Friction Surfacing.
