### **A9 Southbound Dual Carriageway – Carriageway Improvement Works. (Between Munloch Junction and North Kessock Junction).**

Users of the A9 trunk road, on the southbound carriageway between the Munloch and North Kessock Junctions (410 metres), are set to benefit from a Transport Scotland investment of £35, 000 in carriageway patching works and the replacement of road markings and studs.

The works are due to start on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> October 2011 and last for one day, (0930 to 2100). The traffic management, single lane closure with convoy working, will be closely monitored. Supervision of the scheme will be carried out by Scotland Transerv on behalf of Transport Scotland. Emergency services will have unrestricted access at all times.
