A 830/B8006 Junction, Lochyside, Fort William, Traffic Signals with Pedestrian/Cycle crossing facilities

Work starts on Monday 30th August 2010 on the installation of traffic signals at the junction of the A830 and the B8006 Kilmallie road, at Lochyside. Fort William, These signals will also incorporate pedestrian/cycle crossing facilities.

Work will be carried out by Scotland Transerv, on behalf of Transport Scotland, between the hours of 0900hours and 1530 hours, Monday to Friday, and last for three weeks. To allow the works to be carried out in safety a single lane closure will be in place with temporary traffic lights.

Access to the emergency services will be available at all times. The works will be constructed in a safe manner and in a way which minimises disruption. There will be close liaison with affected parties during the works.
