A828 'Sutherlands Grove' Barcaldine, Argyll

Users of the A828 trunk 'Sutherlands Grove', Barcaldine, Argyll, is set to benefit from a £165,000 road improvement scheme.

The scheme is due to start on Sunday 11th July 2010 and is planned to complete at 0600 hours on Friday 23rd July 2010.

The scheme extends from mid-Barcaldine to a point 1.3km (0.8 miles) to the north. The work will involve resurfacing, lining, some drainage work and also include the application of high friction surfacing.

The works, which will be carried out by Scotland Transerv on behalf of Transport Scotland, will be carried out between 2100 hours and 0600 hours, Monday to Friday. To allow the works to be carried out in safety a road closure will be in place. Traffic movement will not be subject to Traffic Management outwith the closure times and from 0600 hours on Friday morning until 2100 hours on the following Sunday evening.

The works will be constructed in a safe manner and in way which minimises disruption. There will be close liaison with affected parties during the works.

Every attempt will be made to ensure that access to business premises and residential properties will, as far as possible, be maintained throughout the construction period. Emergency vehicles will have unrestricted access.
