Roadworks on the A9 at Inver

Users of the A9 trunk road at Inver are set to benefit from a £229,000 road maintenance scheme.

The maintenance scheme comprises planing, re-surfacing and re-lining of 0.6 miles (1km) of carriageway and is part of Transport Scotland's ongoing investment in the A9.

The scheme starts approximately 400 yards north of the A822 / A923 junction at Dunkeld and continues northwards for a distance of approximately 0.6 miles (1km).

The works which will be supervised by Scotland Transerv on behalf of Transport Scotland, will be carried out from 7pm to 6am and start on Sunday 9th May 2010. They are planned to be complete by 6am on Friday 21st May 2010. There will be no Saturday working.

For the safety of the public and workers, traffic management will be in place with single lane closure and convoy working with speeds reduced to 30mph. There will be two-way traffic during the day subject to a 30 mph speed restriction.
