A9 Roadworks at Faskally

Users of the A9 trunk road at Faskally are set to benefit from a Transport Scotland investment of £1.2 million.

The works involve essential carriageway refurbishment at the northern junction to Pitlochry. In addition, new signing, lining and safety barrier installation will be carried out..

To improve safety at this location the junction layouts and line markings will be altered so this short section of carriageway has only one running lane in each direction.

A spokesman for Scotland Transerv said;

'This work is essential refurbishment and safety improvements at this junction. We continue to be grateful to the public for their patience and we will make every effort to ensure that any delays are kept to a minimum.'

The 24 hour works are programmed to be carried out continuously from midnight Thursday 10th February 2011 until late Friday 25th March 2011. For the safety of road workers and road users alike, traffic management will be carried out under contraflow with diversions in place when slip roads are closed and single lanes on the approaches to the works

The works will be supervised by Scotland Transerv on behalf of Transport Scotland.
