A84 Kilmahog to Lochearnhead

Overnight Road Closure - From 10pm Sunday 12th June 2011 until 0600 hours on Friday 17th June 2011.

Users of the A84 between Kilmahog and Lochearnhead are set to benefit from a Transport Scotland investment of £50,000 in a resurfacing scheme. The work involves essential surfacing works along Loch Lubnaig side. To allow these works to proceed in safety for the public and road workers alike a road closure will be in place.

The A84 will be closed from the A821 Jct Kilmahog to the A84/85 Jct Lochearnhead each night from 2200 to 0600, starting at 10pm Sunday 12th June 2011 until 0600 hours on Friday 17th June 2011.

The work will be carried out by Scotland Transerv on behalf of Transport Scotland. As safety permits local access will be maintained. Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.

A spokesman for Scotland Transerv said;

‘These essential works will significantly improve the ride quality of the A84 trunk road between Kilmahog and Lochearnhead. Out with the closure period the road will be open to all traffic.’

Diversions will be in place and motorists should allow extra time for their journeys and pay attention to any advisory signs which will be in place throughout the works. For real time journey planning information visit www.trafficscotland.org
