A9 Kessock Bridge

Users of the A9 Kessock Bridge are set to benefit from a £80,000 Transport Scotland improvement scheme. The works, which involve the installation of a gate within the existing crossover at the south end of the bridge, will allow the quicker set up of traffic management during future works/incidents.

The two week programme of night-time works (7pm to 7am) gets underway on Monday 9th May 2011. There will be no works on the nights of Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th May, 2011. For the safety of road workers and users alike, works will be carried out using fast lane closures.

A spokesman for Scotland Transerv said;

‘The installation of the crossovers will allow future closures of the dual carriageway to be managed more rapidly and in a much safer way.’

The work will be carried out by Scotland Transerv on behalf of Transport Scotland.
