A85 Glenogle Cottages – £210,000 of improvements

A £210,000 package of works is set to bring benefits to users of the A85 trunk road travelling between Lochearnhead and Crianlarich.

Scotland TranServ, acting on behalf of Transport Scotland, will carry out the essential carriageway maintenance on this vital trunk road.

Construction of the Transport Scotland funded scheme is currently programmed to commence on the 8th of August and to last for approximately 2 weeks.

During construction, the trunk road will be reduced to one lane under temporary traffic signal control, with 10mph convoy working in place. The work will be carried out Monday to Friday, from 07.00 to 18.00 hours.

Out with working hours, and throughout the weekends, traffic management will be lifted to assist the easy flow of traffic.

Local access will be maintained when it is safe to do so and emergency services will have unrestricted access at all times.
