

A83 Rest and Be Thankful Landslip

Date: 9th September 2009

On 8th September following a prolonged period of heavy rain a landslip occurred on the A83 Rest and be Thankful.

After the site operations to remove the debris from the road surface and adjoining areas a site assessment will be carried and until such times as evaluations of hillside stability, supporting embankments and road damage have taken place no timescale can be given regarding road reopening. Road user safety is of vital importance in circumstances such as this and will be the overriding factor in all decisions taken.
